Photojournalist Jennifer Latheef of the Maldives was sentenced to 10 years in prison for photographing a peaceful protest. While in prison, guards threatened her with torture and drowning. Her captors kicked her with steel-toed boots, resulting in a spinal injury. Amnesty International activists from around the world sent letters to the authorities, calling for Jennifer's release. In August 2006, authorities freed her before she had served one year of her 10-year sentence.
